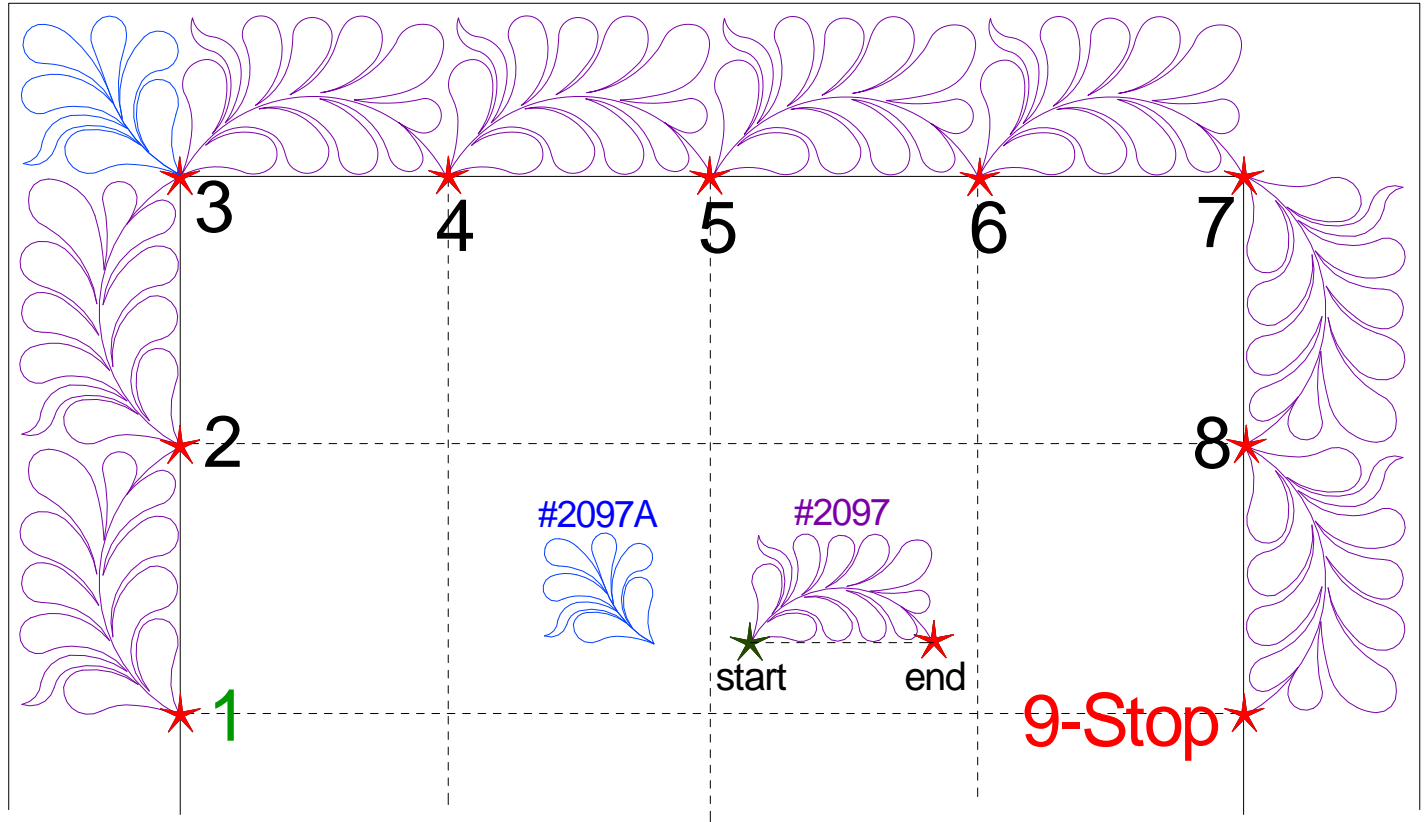


#2097 & #2097A Simple Feather Border & Corner Instructions for using with P2P Pattern in Creative Studio

Any pattern that has the start and ends on the outer edges of the pattern and also on the same horizontal line can be used with P2P pattern in CS or PS. This can speed up your borders considerably, especially when they are a little crooked. Patterns that have corners like the one shown below work best for this method.



- *Choose the border pattern you wish to use.
- *Make sure freeze aspect is on and set to desired height. (Determined by quilt border size minus margins)
- *Turn off freeze aspect.
- *Look at pattern properties and see what the pattern width has been changed to. You will want to click the points about this far apart. It is a plus when you can find a pattern that fits nicely with your quilt blocks, this will eliminate having to measure to see where your points should fall. (See illustration above) If you don't have blocks to gauge the distance, try a longarm centering tape with sliders or painters tape with the distances marked.
- *Click on P2P Pattern and click the sequence as shown above on the red stars. Start at 1 and go all the way to 9, then click Stop. When you look at the screen you should see all of your patterns as they look above. They will stitch continuously and be perfectly lined up with your border.
- *When you have stitched the border, add the corners.
- *Choose the corner pattern, freeze aspect and set to the same height as the border pattern.
- *Choose Repeat Pattern. Click OK near the corner on the quilt. Now rotate and drag the corner pattern into position and stitch.
- *Repeat for the remaining corner.
- *Continue with the quilt by clicking the points from the belly bar to the take up roller on the left side and from the take up roller to the belly bar on the right.
- *When you get to the bottom, click the points from right to left to rotate the pattern and stitch it in the correct direction.
