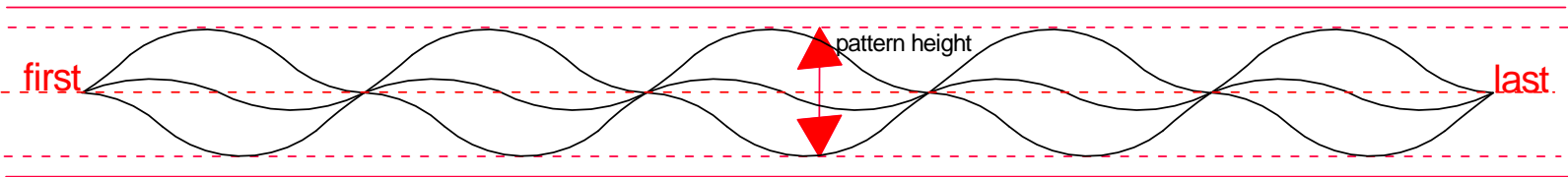

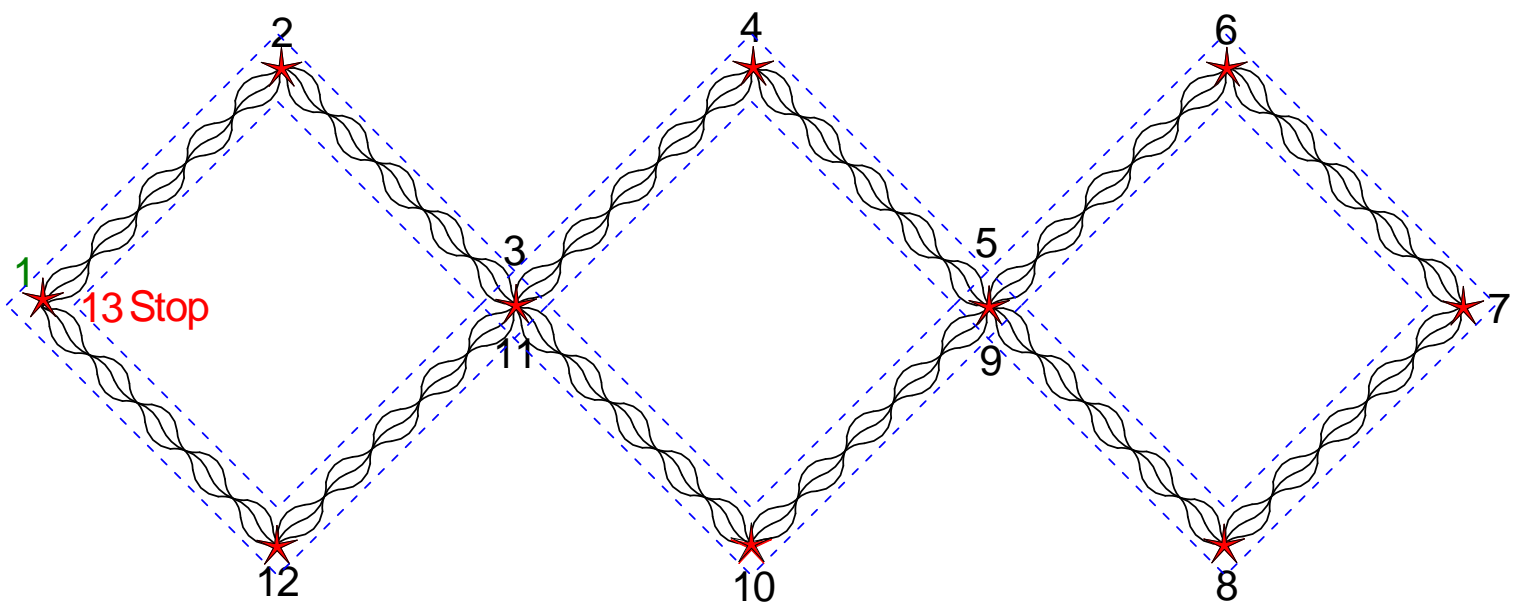
Instructions for using P2P Pattern in Creative Studio

Any pattern that has the start and ends on the outer edges of the pattern and also on the same horizontal line can be used with P2P pattern in CS or PS. The block must be positioned so first is at the left and last is at the right. (See pattern below.) The length will be determined by the points that you click. Patterns can be sewn in any direction. This can speed up your sash areas considerably, especially with diagonal sets. Patterns like the one shown below work best for this method. The pattern will need to be designed long enough to fit in the proportions of your sash rectangle so it doesn't distort too much. Having patterns on hand that will fit different size areas is a big time saver. See set #420 in the store at www.tkquilting.com.



- *Choose the sash pattern you wish to use.
- *Set pattern to desired height in pattern properties box. (Determined by quilt sash size minus margins, see illustration above.)
- *Turn off freeze aspect.
- *Click on P2P Pattern icon and click the sequence with your machine head, as shown below on the red stars. Start at 1 and go all the way to 13, then click Stop. When you look at the screen you should see all of your patterns as they look below. They will stitch continuously and save you a lot of tie-offs and time. You may choose to click a reference boundary around the sash areas, but it is not necessary. When you are ready, click quilt and stitch.
